This Helvella species was found on grassy soil under Betula pubescens at the sea level. The very bad picture doesn't shows the hollow and <u>villose</u> stipe and the <u>furfuraceous</u> (only furfuraceous, not villose) ectal excipulum of the fruit bodys. Head up to 40 x 20 mm; stipe up to 35 x 5 mm. Could be H. elastica?
